Dear Friends, in the summer of 2015, Pope Francis had a gathering with the youth in the city of Rome. Excitingly, 9000 of them were Altar servers from Italy, Germany and Austria. The holy Father's message to them was simple and very encouraging. He spoke to them about how fortunate we Catholics are to have Jesus so close to us through our experience of the Eucharist. Through this sacrament, we know that God is not far off, but that we experience his intimate closeness and the power of his presence.

The theme of his gathering with the youth that summer was "Here I am! Send me" from the prophet Isaiah. Our young altar servers are more fortunate today than the prophet Isaiah was in his time. In the Eucharist, Jesus is right there in the bread and wine that transforms into his body and blood. Isaiah was sent to bring God's word to others. He realized that if he entrusted himself into God's hands, his whole life would be transformed."

Like Isaiah, we recognize that it is always God who takes the lead, because it is he who created us and willed us into being. In our baptism, he made us into a new creation and is always patient, waiting for our response to his call.

Today we rejoice that 7 of our young brothers and sisters have said yes to God's call to become altar servers. They are:
